the tray



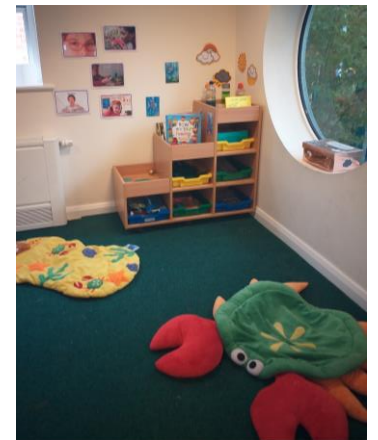
hang up your bag,
